The CUIC Institute for Ecumenism Begins!

The CUIC Institute for Ecumenism will launch its first class in May. This concept, long in the planning, will bring together young adults from the various participating communions in CUIC.

The first cohort will meet monthly via Zoom between May 2024 and March 2025. The sessions will cover topics including the scriptural and theological groundings for ecumenism, the history of the ecumenical and interreligious movements, multi-lateral and bi-lateral dialogues, among others. Most of the instructors for the Institute will also come from CUIC member communions.

The Institute is intended to address the lack of ecumenical faith formation opportunities in the United States. Through this initiative, CUIC seeks to spark greater interest among young adults in the ecumenical movement and develop new leaders within our various denominations.


